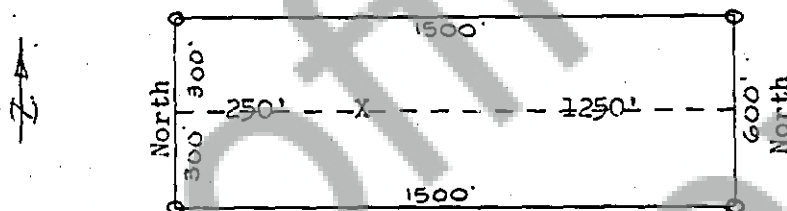
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim is named SILVER STAR 24 B situated on land belonging to the United States of America located within the Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, Washington, and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by James J. Owens a citizen of the United States, and agent for AMOCO MINERALS CO.

This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 250 feet East of the West End Center. The general course of this claim is East - West.

The Discovery is SOUTH 2140' & EAST 870' from the SILVER STAR I.P. monument at the intersection of two dirt roads situate in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M.

All corners are marked by Blazed Trees or Rock Cairns w/metal tags as shown on the following sketch.



The I.P. monument is approximately 1385 feet S.33 E. from the confluence of Copper Creek and Miners Creek.
