

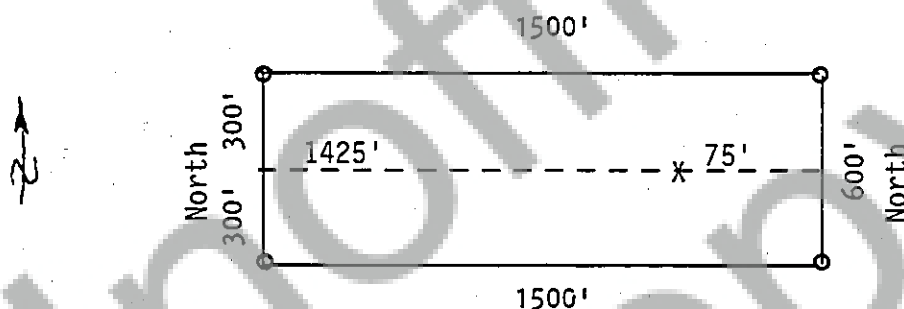
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This claim is being amended and relocated by James J. Owens, a citizen of the United States, and agent for AMOCO MINERALS CO., being 1500 ft. long and 600 ft. wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 75 ft. West of the East End Center with the general course of the claim being East West North and South.

The Discovery is SOUTH 3085' & EAST 4090' from the SILVER STAR I.P.monument at the intersection of two dirt roads situate in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M.
