## HAZARD TO SWEENEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Harry Hazard, party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Mary<sup>E</sup>/Sweeney and John F. Sweeney parties of the second part, herein, do hereby grant, release and quit claim unto the said Mary E. Sweeney and John F. Sweeney the following real estate in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit: commencing at the southwest corner of lot 16 in Block 7 Riverview Addition to the Town of Stevensoh, according to the official plat thereof, thence N. 55 deg 30' E. 175 feet to a place of beginning, thence N. 34 deg. 30' W 105 feet, thence N. 55 deg. 30' E. to the west side of Kanaka Creek Road, thence following the west side of Kanaka Creek Road southerly to the intersection thereof with the north side of Second Street, thence S 55 deg. 30' W to the place of beginning.

The said real estate being included in that described in a certain indenture of mortgage bearing date September 27th. 1912, made and executed by Mary E. Sweeney and John F. Sweeney her husband, parties of the first part therein, to Harry Hazard party of the second part therein, recorded on the 28th day of September 1912 in Book L of Mortgages at page 227, it being the intention hereby to release the said property from the terms of the said mortgage, and that the said property shall be discharged from any lien thereunder, but
