All of an undivided one half of the southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section three (3) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, save and except the North fifteen (15) acres thereof; the land hereby conveyed being in undivided one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) interest in twenty-five (25) acres of land, more or less, in the county and state aforesaid.
