Young of Heppner, Oregon, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said J.B. Young his heirs and assigns all the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

Commencing at the N.W. Corner of Lot eight (8), running thence East thirty two (32) rods, thence south to the south line of Lot five (5), thence West to the S.W. Corner of Lot five (5) thence North to the place of beginning.
