

Vancouver, Washington General Land Office No.0684

The United States of America to all whome these presents shall come Greeting:
Wherras in pursuance of the provisions of the revised statutes of the United States Chapter six title thirty two and legislation appplemental thereto/there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Filed Notes of survey and the Certificate No.0684 of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver in the state of Washington accompanied by other evidence whereby it ap ears that the heirs of Dell Stuart, the heirs of Victor Carlson, and A.Hoofer, did, on the fifteenth day of January A.D.1907 duly enter and pay for that certain mining claim or premises known as the Chicago No.1 and Chicago No.2 lode mining claims, designated by the Survevor General as Survey No.829, embracing a portion of Sections twenty nine and thirty two in Township ten North of Range six East of Willamette Meridian in the St.Helens mining district in the County of Skamania State of Washington in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver, and bounded and described and platted as follows with magnetic variation twenty four degrees east:

Beginning, for the description of the Chicago No.1 lode claim, at corner No.1 a fir post five inches square three feet high marked 1-829 from which the corner common to sections twenty nine, thirty thirtyone and thirty two in Township ten north of Range six East of the Willamette Meridian, bears north seventy five degrees, fifty three minutes west six hundred twenty seven and fourteen hundredths feet distant, and U.S. Location monument No.2 bears south twenty one degrees twenty two minutes thirty seconds east seven hundred two and seventy four hundredths feet distant; thence first course, south twenty one degrees forty eight minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2, a fir post five inches square three feet high, maked 2-829 and 2-829; thence second course/north forty seven degrees forty nine minutes east three hundred twenty feet to a point from which discovery post bears north forty degrees east four feet distant; six hundred forty feet to corner No.3 a hemlock post five inches square thre feet high masked 3-829 and 1-829; thence third course, north twney one degrees forty eight minutes west one thousand one hundred fifty. five and nine hundredths feet intersect line between said sections twenty nine and thirty two; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.4, a larch post five inshes square three feet hight marked 4-829; thence fourth course, south forty seven degrees forty ine minutes west four hundred fifty two and sixteen hundredths feet interesect line between section twenty-nine and thirty two six hundred forty feet to corner No.1 the place of beginning, the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in lenght along said Chicago No.1 vein or lode;

Beginning, for the des cription of the Chicago No.2 Lode claim, at corner No.1 identical with corner No.3 of said chicago claim No.1 lode claim from which the quarter corner between sections twenty nine and thity two bears north forty four degrees twenty seven minutes forty seconds east one thousand four hnundred thirty and seven tenths feet distant; thence first course south forty seven degrees forty nine minutes west three hundred twenty feet to a point from which discovery post bears south thirty five degrees west seven feet distant, six hundred forty feet to corner No.2 identical with corner No.2 of said Chicago No.1 lode claim; thence second course, south twenty one degrees forty eight minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3 a fir post five inshes square three feet hight marked 3-829; thence third course, north forty seven degrees forty nine minutes east six hundred forty feet to corner No.4 a hemlock post five inches square three feet hight marked 4-829; thence fourth course, north twenty one degrees forty eight minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.1 the place of beginning, the survey of the said lode
