Know all men by these presents that We J.L.Wendorf and Belle J Wendorf husband and wife of Portland, Oregon in consideration of one dollar to us paid by W.A.Wendorf of Underwood, Wash. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargain and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W.A.Wendorf his heirs and assigns all the following bounded and described property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to wit:

Beginning at a point 56 rods west of the southeast corner of Northeast quarter of section sixteen in Township three North of Range ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian, running thence north forty rods, thence west twenty four rods, thence south forty rods, thence east twenty four rods to place of beginning containing six acres, together with the tenements hereditament and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and also all our right title and interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower. To have and to hold the above described and granted premises unto the said W.A.Wendorf his heirs and assigns forever. And the said J.L.Wendorf and Belle J.Wendorf, grantors above named do covenant to and with the said W.A.Wendorf his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said granted premises that the same are free from all incumbrances and that we will and our heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
