

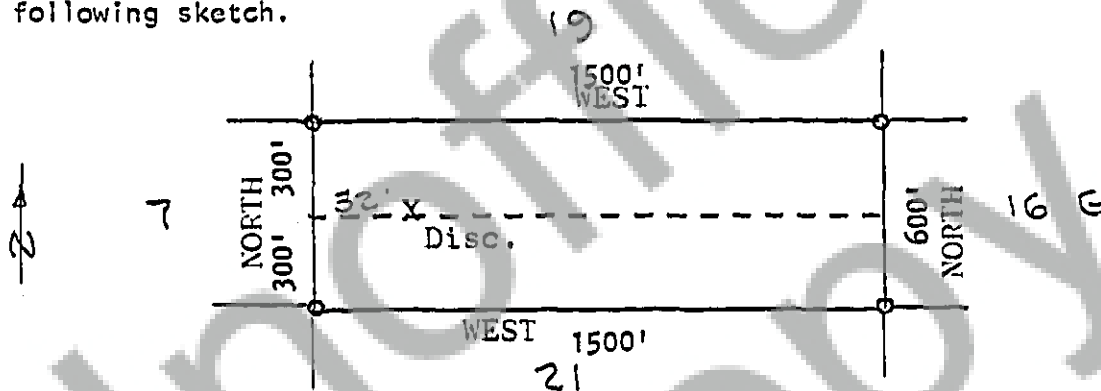
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

All corners are marked by Blazed Trees or Rock Cairns w/metal tags as shown on the following sketch.



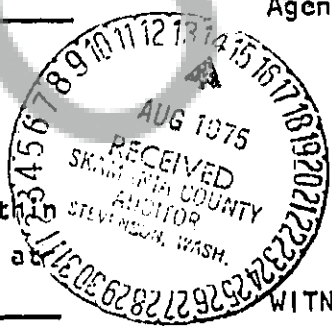
