

BIGHAM TO ZINIKER

REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE
Statutory Form

The Mortgagors Harry Bigham and Sarah C. Bigham husband and wife of Washougal in the state of Washington mortgage to John Ziniker of said Washougal to secure the payment of Four Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent. per annum from date until paid, according to the terms and conditions of one certain promissory note bearing even date herewith made by said Harry Bigham and Sarah C. Bigham payable on the fourteenth day of November 1918 to the order of said John Ziniker the following described real estate to-wit: Beginning at a point 25 rods north of south-west corner of the north-east quarter of section 9 in township one north of range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania county, Washington and running thence east 30 rods, thence north 32 rods to the county road, thence west 30 rods, thence south to the place of beginning, containing 6 acres more or less. Also an acre cornering on the above described property on the north-east being bounded on the south by the north line of the above described property, if extended east to the certain creek, thence in a north-westerly direction down said creek to a point due north of the east line of the real property above described, thence south to the place of beginning all situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington.
