Churchill of Portland, Oregon, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Allan J. Churchill his heirs and assigns all the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

The East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section twenty-seven (27) in Township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, containing twenty (20) acres. Both grantors and grantee herein are to have and retain access to that certain spring of water near the line of this granted tract and the right to reasonable use of the water thereof.

Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and also all our right title and interest in and to the same including dower and claim of dower. To have and to hold the above described premises unto the said Allan J. Churchill his heirs and assigns forever.
