Shepard to Morrison

The grantors H. Warren Shepard and Anna R. Shepard his wife for and in consideration of ten (\$10.00) dollars in hand paid, convey and warrant to Frank D. Morrison the following described real estate to-wit:

Beginning at the quarter corner on the west line of section nineteen (19) Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of Willamette Meridian, thence one thousand eight hundred and fourteen (1814) feet in a northerly direction along said west line to a point from which a fir tree forty (40) inches in diameter bears north seventy five degrees west and six and six tenths (6.6) feet distant, marked H.S., and a maple eight inches in diameter bears south thirty degrees east twenty three and seven tenths (23.7) feet distant marked H.S., thence one thousand and seven (1007) feet in an easterly direction along the south line of the J.A. Holmes tract to a point from which a fir stump forty eight inches in diameter bears north five degrees west and nineteen feet distant and marked H.S. and a fir snag thirty inches in diameter bears south ten degrees west and thirty-three and six tenths feet distant, marked H.S., thence one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine (1839) feet in a southerly direction following the general course of the bottom of the ravine, to a point on the south line of the Northwest quarter of above named section, from which a fir snag twelve inches in diameter bears north ten degrees east fifteen feet distant marked H.S. and a fir snag twenty four inches in diameter bears west twenty and two tenths feet distant, marked H.S., thence in a westerly direction along the south line of said northwest quarter to the quarter corner on the west line of said section nineteen noted as the point of beginning, containing thirty-two and one hundredths acres more or less.
