The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Hiram W. Sibley, being the owner of a tract of land situated and included within the limits of a public forest reservation, known and officially designated as the Cascade Range Forest Reserve, in Oregon, has under the provisions of the act approved June 4th 1897, entitled an act making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, 1898 and for other purposes" reconveyed and relinquished the said tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of said Act, selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of vacant public land now open for settlement to-wit: The South half of the Southeast quarter of Section twenty-three in Township two North of Range five East of the Willamette Meridian Washington, containing eighty acres Now therefore Know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Hiram W. Sibley and to his heirs, the land above described; To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever kind thereunto belonging unto the said Hiram W. Sibley and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.
