

STATEMENT OF ANNUAL LABOR FOR THE YEAR
ENDING AUGUST 31, 1975

Useful work and improvements in the amount of more than \$23,100.00 were done and made during the period from December 11, 1974 to August 31, 1975 by Long-year Company, P. O. Box 15218, Salt Lake City, Utah 84115, at the request of AMOCO Minerals Company, whose address is 333 West Hampden, Englewood, Colorado 80110 for all of the lode mining claims listed in attached "Exhibit A", located in the Silver Star mining district, Skamania County, Washington.

A total of 231 contiguous mining claims are included in this statement.

Work and improvements required more than 780 man-days of labor, consisting of 11,121 feet of diamond core drilling completed in twelve holes, as follows:
