Martin and Jean Elizabeth Martin, of the County of Multnomah State of Oregon parties of the second part, WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand and No/100 Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all of lots one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7) and eight (8) in Block nine (9), of the Town of Stevenson according to the official plat of said Town now on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington.
