The United States of America

To all wo thom these presents shall come , greeting:

Whereas William A.Orser, being theowner of a tract of land described as follows:

the Lots numbered four and five of Section one and the lots numbered one, eight and nine
of Section two in Township foundNorth of Range nine East of Willamette peridian in
Washington containing one hundred and fifty three acres and seventy three hundredths
ofan acre. situated and included within the limits of a public forest reservation known
and officially designated as the Mount Rainier Forest Reserve in the State of Washington
has under the provision of the act approved June 4th 1897 entitled "an Act making
appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government fo the fiscal year ending
June thirtieth eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and for other purposes, "reconveyed and
relinquished to said tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of said act
selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of vacant public land now open
for settlement, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section one and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section twenty four in Township three North of Range nine East and the Lots numbered four and five of Section six in Township three North of Range ten East of Willamette Meridian in Washington, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and eighty three hundred of an acore.

Now, Know Yerthat the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the aforesaid act have gievn and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William A.Orser and to his heirs and asigns the lands last above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Willaim A.Orser and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States. In Witness Whereof I Theodore Roosevelt President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and theoseal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of Washington th fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five and of the Independence of the United States the twenty-ninth.
