This Indenture made this 19th day of February 1910 between Amos D. St. Martin and Grace D. St. Martin, husband and wife, of Yakima County Washington, the parties of the first part and G. G. Lee, Trustee, of Yakima County Washington, party of the second part, witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other good and valuable considerations lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant bargain, sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract lot or parcel of land situated lying and being in the county of Skamania State of Washington, particularly described
