Wash. To have and to hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns that they are the owners in fee simple of said premises and that they are free from all incumbrances except a certain mortgage for \$100.00 bearing date of March 9th 1908 in favor of Harry Hazard, which mortgage grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay and that we will warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever.
