The United states of America, to all to whome these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas in pursuance of the Provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United states Chapter six, Title thirty-two and legislation supplemental thereto, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United states the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and certificate No 0704 of the register of the Land Office at Vancouver in the state of Washington, accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that E.A. Sessions, for himself, and as trustee for J.M.Gray, W.A.Gray, G.W.Simpson, R Palitzsch, A.R.Zeller and J.F Boone, did on the seventeenth day of January A.D.1906 duly enter and pay for that certain mining claim or premises known as the Germania No.1, Germania Junior No.1, Germania Junior No.2, Germania Secundus No.1, Ardentine No.1, Zenith No.1, Germania Secundus No.2, Germania No.2, Ardentine No.2, Zenith No.2, and Adamantine No.2 lode mining claims, designated by the Surveyor General as Survey No.708, embracing a portion of sections seventeen and eighteen in Township ten North of Range six East and a portion of Township ten north of Range six East of the Willamette meridian, in the t.Helens unorganized Mining District in the county of Skamania and State of Washington, in the district of land subject to sale at Vancouver and bounded and described and platted as follows, with magnetic variation as hereinafter stated:

Beginning for the description of the Germania No.1 lode claim, at corner No.1, 1-4-708 and 3-689 A marked on cedar tree with a tack at the base, identical with corner No.3 of Survey No.689 A, the Polar Star Junior No.1 lode claim, from which U.S.Monument No.3 bears south seventy three degrees thirty eight minutes fifty eight seconds west four thousand five hundred twenty nine and forty nine hundredths feet distant; and the corner to sections seven, eight, seventeen and eighteen in Township ten North of Range six east of Willamette meridian bears north forty degrees nine minutes twenty seconds east nine hundred six and thirty six hundredths feet distant; thence first course, magnetic variation twenty one degrees forty-seven minutes east, north sixty seven degrees, fifty nine minutes east one thousand three hundred nine feet to corner No.2 a cedar post four feet long four inches square marked 2-708, 3-708, 4-708, and 1-708, with mound of pumice stone; thence second course, magnetic variation twenty two degrees east, north three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes west seventy feet distant, six hundred feet to corner No.3, a cedar post four feet long four inches square, marked 3-708, 4-708, 1-708 and 2-708 with mound of pumice stone; thence third course, magnetic variation twenty-one degrees thirty eight minutes east south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes west, one
