Beginning for the description of the Germania Junior No.1 lode claim, at corner No.1/a Hemlock post four feet long four inches square marked 1-708 and 4-708 with mound of pumice stone, from which U.S. Monument No.3 bears south eighty one degrees forty five minutes, forty eight seconds west four thousand two hundred twelve and sixty nine hundredths feet distant; and said section corner bears north twenty nine degrees ten minutes seventeen seconds east one thousand five hundred sixty two and fifty two hundredths feet distant; thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty one degrees thirty minutes east, north sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2 a cedar post four feet long, five inches square marked 2-708, 1-708, 4-708 and 3-708 with mound of stone; thence second course magnetic variations twenty one degrees east north three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes west seventy five feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.3 identical with corner No.2 of said Germania No.1 lode claim; thence third course south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes west one thousand three hundred feet to corner No.4 identical with corner No.1 of said Germania No.1 lode claim; thence fourth course, south sixty four degrees forty five minutes west one hundred ninety five feet and seventy five hundredths feet to corner No.5 a cedar post five inches square four feet long marked 5-708 with mound of pumice stone; thence fifth course magnetic variation twenty two degrees twenty minutes east, south five hundred eighty eight feet and nine tenths feet to corner No.1 the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Germania Junior No.1 vein or lode:

Beginning for the description of the Germania Secundus No.1 lode claim at corner No.1 a hemlock post four feet long four inches marked 1-708 from which U.S. Location monument No.3 bears south eighty nine degrees fifty seven minutes six seconds west four thousand one hundred sixty nine and twenty three hundredths feet distant; and said corner bears North twenty one degrees eleven minutes thirty two seconds east two thousand one hundred six and eighty two hundredths feet distant; thence first course, magnetic variation twenty two degrees east, north sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.2 a cedar post four feet long four inches square marked 2-708 and 1-708 with mound of pumice stone; thence second course north three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes west one hundred fifty feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.3 identical with corner No.2 of said Germania Junior No.1 lode; Thence third course south sixty seven degrees fifty nine minutes one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.4 identical with corner No.1 of said Germania Junior No.1 lode claim; thence fourth course south six hundred feet to corner No.1 the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Germania Secundus No.1 vein or lode;

Beginning for the description of the Argentine No.1 lode claim at corner No.1 a pipe post four feet long four inches square marked 1-708 with mound of pumice stone, from which the U.S. Location monument No.3 bears south sixty six degrees thirty six minutes twenty eight seconds west four thousand five hundred forty two and fifty nine hundredths feet distant; and said section corner bears north seventy seven degrees forty nine minutes twenty four seconds east seven hundred seventy nine and fourteen hundredths feet distant; thence first course
