## VALLETT TO BANK OF STEVENSON

THIS INDENTURE made this 12th day of March 1914 between Monroe Vallett, a single man, party of the first part and Bank of Stevenson, a Washington corporation party of the second part, witnesseth:

That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and no/100 dollars, lawful money of the United States, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged does by these presents grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, the following real property in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 31.47 chains east of the southwest corner of the north half of the Shepherd D.L.C. the said corner being situated 15.75 chains east and 20.97 chains north of the quarter section corner to sections one and thirty-six township two and three north of range 7 East of W.M.; thence running  $3\frac{1}{2}$  chains in a southeasterly direction along the bed of a small stream; thence east 12.5 chains until it connects with the south line of the Monroe Vallett place (deeded by A.W. Lambert to said Monroe Vallett by deed
