St. Martin, of Yakima County, Washington, the party of the second part: Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot, or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit: The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 21, Township 3 North, of Range 8, E.W.M. Also certain real estate lying adjacent to said property in said county and belonging to Isadore St. Martin, Sr., at the time of his death and now belonging to his estate, the exact description of which is unknown. Also quit-claiming all of the interest of the first party in and to any and all other property coming from the estate of the said Isadore St. Martin, deceased.
