foreclosed at any time thereafter.

And it is also expressly agreed between said parties that if any suit is instituted to effect such foreclosure, by reason of any such default, the party to such suit holding this mortgage may recover therein as attorney's fees such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable, in addition to costs and disbursments allowed by the code of civil procedure, and said attorney's fees and costs shall be secured by this mortgage.
