CAPE HORN RAILROAD COMPANY TO WASHINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Cape Horn Railroad Company, a corporation duly organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington in consideration of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations to it paid by Washington Northern Railroad Company, a corporation, does hereby grant, bargain sell and convey to said Washington Northern Railroad Company, its successors and assigns forever, the following described parcel of real estate, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, to-wit:

That certain right of way granted by Frank O. Ziegler and Amelia L. Ziegler, his wife, to the said Cape Horn Railroad Company, by deed dated the 28th day of May, 1910, and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land one hundred (100) feet in width, being fifty (50) feet on each side of the center line of the railroad to be constructed by the grantee hereunder, or its successors and assigns, over and across the west half of the northwest quarter of Section Twenty-five (25) in Township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian as said railroad is now located thereon, as shown by graded roadbed, or as same may hereafter be relocated by the grantee, its successors or assigns.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and also all its estate, right, title and interest, at law and equity, therein and thereto.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Washington Northern Railroad Company, its successors and assigns forever.
