MERZ TO NOBLE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, F. Merz the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by H.E.Noble the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto the said party of the second part, a certain INDENTURE OF MORTGAGE, bearing date the 28th day of May, A.D.One Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen, made and executed by Fred Kriews and Clara Kriews, his wife to the said party of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars, together with the Five notes or obligations therein described, and the money due, or to grow due thereon, with the interest; which said Indenture of Mortgage was recorded in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania State of Washington in Book M of Mortgages, page 325 on the 4th day of June, A.D.1914
