WEEKS TO BRISTOL
Release of Mortgage

THIS INDENTURE, Made on the 26th day of January A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen, by and between Mary S. Arnoldia Weeks, of the City of New York, State of New York, party of the first part, and Leland C. Bristol and Alice C. Bristol his wife, of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth:
