

Lode Claim on Public Domain

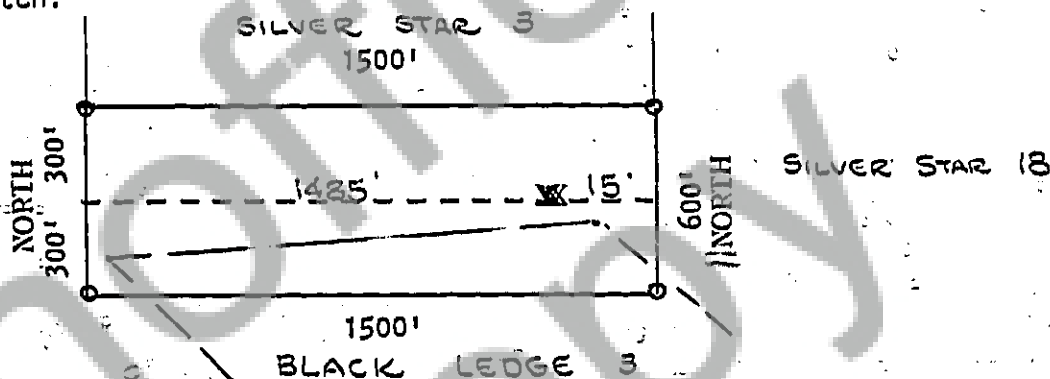
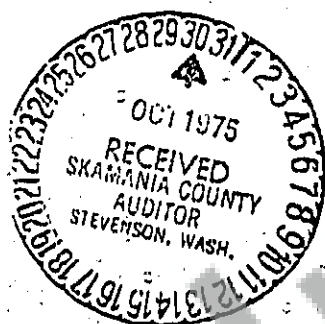
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim is named SILVER STAR 4 situated on land belonging to the United States of America in Section 4 & 5 T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W. M., Copper Creek Mining District located on 29 Oct. 74 by Amoco Minerals Co. and filed and recorded in Book L on Page 875 records of County Recorder, Skamania County, Washington.

This claim is being amended and relocated by James J. Owens, a citizen of the United States, and agent for AMOCO MINERALS CO., being 1500 ft. long and 600 ft. wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 15 ft. WEST of the EAST End Center with the general course of the claim being East and West.

The Discovery is NORTH 1215' and WEST from the SILVER STAR I.P. at the intersection of two dirt roads situate in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M. approx. S.33°E. 1385' from confluence of Copper & Miners Creeks.

All corners are marked by Blazed Trees or Rock Cairns w/metal tags as shown on the following sketch.
