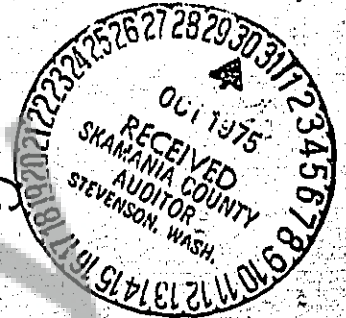
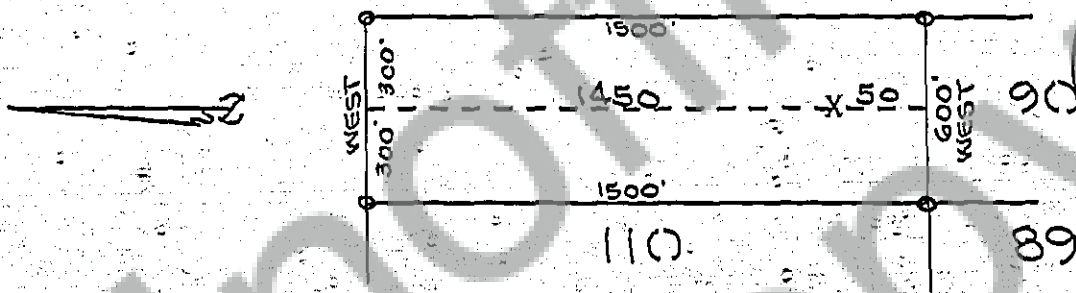
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim is named SILVER STAR 110-A situated on land belonging to the United States of America located within the Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, Washington, and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by James J.
