To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate numbered 0626 of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver Washington wherea by it appears that under the provisions of the act of congress approved the 27th day of September 1860. entitled an act to create the office of surveyor General of the public lands in Oregon and to provide for the survey and to make donations to settlers of the said public lands, and the legislation supplemental thereto, the claim of Isaac H. Bush and Julia Ann Bush his wife, Notification No. 296, has been established, according to the official plat of survey returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of the D. F. Bradford Donation Land claim No. 37, the same being at point on the east line of the Isaac H. Bush claim No. 296, five and ninety hundredths chains north twenty nine degrees east of the quarter section corner on the west side of section 11 in Township two North of Range seven East of the Willamette meridian, Washington which is also an angle corner of said claims as described by the surveyor general; thence west thirty three and forty hundredths chains; thence south eighty chains, thence east fifty and thirty hundredths chains intersection the west boundary of the donation claim of D. F. Bradford at a point four and ninety hundredths chains north of the angle corner as described by the surveyor General; thence north thirty five and ten hundredths chains; thence west three and ninety five hundredths chains; thence north twenty three degrees west forty two and fifty hundredths chains, thence north twenty nine degrees east five and ninety hundredths chains to the point of beginning, containing three hundred fifty six and eight hundredths acres.

Now Know ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the Provisions of the act aforesaid has given and granted and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Isaac H. Bush and to his heirs and assigns, the south half, and unto his wife, the said Julia Ann Bush and to her heirs and assigns the north half of the tract of land above described; to have and to hold the said tract with the appurtenances unto the said Isaac H. Bush and his wife Julia Ann Bush and to their heirs and assigns forever, their respective portion as aforesaid.

In Testimony Whereof I, William H. Taft, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the city of Washington the twenty first day of June in the year of our lord one thousand nine hundred and nine and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty third.
