Turner to Peterson & Rummel

Know all men by these presents that we, Harriett A. Turner a widow, as principal is held and firmly bound unto Peter Peterson and Harry J. Rummel in the sum of twelve hundred dollars gold coin of the United States to be paid to the said Peter Peterson and Harry J. Rummel their executors administrators or assigns, for which payment well and truly to be made I hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the 12th day of July 1910

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Harriett A. Turner shall on or before the 12th day of July 1913 make execute and deliver unto the said Peter Peterson and Harry J. Rummel (provided the said Peter Peterson and Harry J. Rummel shall on or before that day have paid to the said Harriett A. Turner the sum of twelve hundred dollars (of which amount five hundred dollars (\$500) has been paid at or before the date of the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) together with interest on deferred payments at the rate of ten per cent per annum annually on the 12th day of July of each year until paid, the price by said Peter Peterson and Harry J. Rummel agreed to be paid therefore) a good and sufficient conveyance with usual covenants except as to taxes thereon assessed after the date of this instrument which said Peterson and Rummel hereby agree to pay for the following described premises situate lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:
