REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

Miller and Mollie M. Miller husband and wife payable on the 6th day of July 1915 to the order of Wm. Woodruff and Hattie Woodruff, husband and wife the following described real estate to-wit: Lots One (1) and Two (2) of the North Half (1/2) of the North West Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township One (1) North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian excepting therefrom a strip of land Three Hundred and Ninety (390) feet wide of the west end of above described tract. Containing 45 acres more or less, situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington.
