North, of the South West Corner of the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter, of Section (21) Twenty One, Township (3) Three, North, Range (8) East, of Willamette Meridian, thence running East (77 Rods 3½ ft) Seventy Seven Rods, Three and One Half Feet, thence North (20 Rd. 6¼ ft) Twenty Rod, Six and One Fourth Feet; thence West (77 Rds, 3½ ft) Seventy Seven Rods, Three and One Half Feet; thence South (20 Rod 6¼) Twenty Rod, Six and One Fourth Feet to a point of beginning, being a tract of land containing (10) Ten Acres more or less.
