

## CLARENCE D. WALKER TO BANK OF STEVENSON.

## ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Clarence D. Walker is the mortgagee, such mortgage being made to secure the sum of TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum, evidenced by one promissory note dated July 6th 1914, said mortgage being of record in Book M Page 339 mortgage records of Skamania County, Washington, together with the promissory note thereby secured.
