



Notice of Mining Claim

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned locator/s have discovered a vein or lode of mineral bearing rock in place upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States, within the State of Washington, and said Mining District; and in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, have located a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post at the point of discovery.

The name of the claim is Treetop #13. This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 100 feet East of the (#5P) West End Center, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is in T.4N R.5E S.22, and further described as being 6 100 feet, more or less, from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to-wit: (W. border) from confluence of E Fork Lewis River & Mc Kinley Creek, up Mc Kinley Creek. The west border is near an unmarked dirt shed in an easterly direction from Mc Kinley Creek. All corners are marked by blazed trees or rock cairns w/ metal tags, where applicable, and witness posts if corners cannot be reached.

Further information to-wit: The whole or any part of Treetop #13 is located on abandoned property.

The adjoining claims are: Treetop #12 on the west end, & Treetop #10 on the south side. See map filed on claim #15
