This Indenture witnesseth that Matthew A.Martin and Gertrude Elnora Martin his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of ten (\$10) dollars lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by William J.Martin and Esther Martin husband and wife, parties of the second part, have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns the following described real property situated and being in the county of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

The East half of the Northwest quarter; the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter and the south half of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of section twenty five (25) Township three (3) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian, except the merchantable timber standing lying and being thereon, and excepting also right of way to remove said timber therefrom, provided however that the said right of way shall be so located as not to unreasonable damage said premises; said timber to be removed on or before December 1st 1912, and said right of way to expire on said date. To have and to hold the said premises with all their appurtenances unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever; and the said Matthew A.Martin and Gertrude Elnora Martin his wife, parties of the first part for themselves and for their heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant to and with the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of above granted premises, that the same are free from all incumbrances except the above mentioned right to remove said timber and that they will warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claims and demands of all persons.
