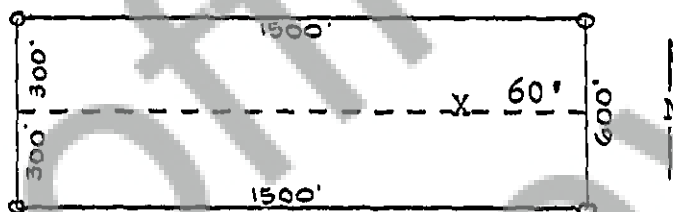
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 60' feet West of the East End Center. The general course of this claim is East - West.

The Discovery is about S. 7100' & E. 2300' from the SILVER STAR I.P. at the intersection of two dirt roads situate in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 3 N., R. 5 E., W.M.
