Portland Quarterly and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note, and in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, we addition to the costs and disbursments provided by statute, such promise and agree to pay in additional sum, in like gold coin, as the Court may adjudge reasonable, for Attorney(s fees to be allowed in said suit or action.
