DuBois, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (800.00) Dollars to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto W.J. & Martha A. Davidson, parties of the second part, the following described premises, to-wit:

The S. 1/2 of the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section fifteen, Township three, North of range ten E.W.M. in Skamania County, Washington, containing twenty acres, more or less. Together with tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances, unto the said W.J. Davidson and Martha A.
