GILLIS TO FALK

THIS INDENTURE, Made the sixteenth day of July one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, BETWEEN E. S. Gillis and Mattie A. Gillis (husband and wife) of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, the parties of the first part, and Anna S. Falk, the party of the second part, Witnesseth; That the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars, Gold Coin of the United States of America, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all those certain pieces and parcels of land situate and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

(1) The east half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section eighteen (18), township one (1) north, range Five (5) east of the Willamette Meridian, containing five (5) acres, more or less.

(2) Also that certain tract of land: Commencing at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section seventeen (17), township one (1) north range five (5) east of the Willamette Meridian, thence east twenty (20) chains, thence south eighteen and one half ($18\frac{1}{2}$) chains, thence due west fourteen (14) chains, thence southwesterly in a straight line to intersect the west boundary ^{line} of section seventeen ($17\frac{1}{2}$) a point nineteen (19) chains north of the southwest corner of said section, thence from this point north twenty-one (21) chains to place of commencement, containing thirty-seven and three quarter ($37\frac{3}{4}$) acres.

TOGETHER with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and the rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever.
