

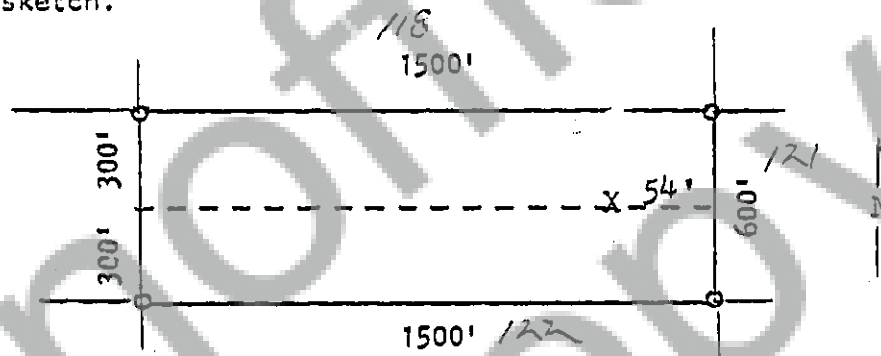
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

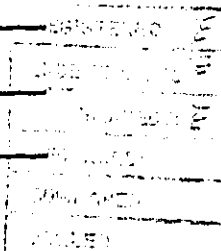
