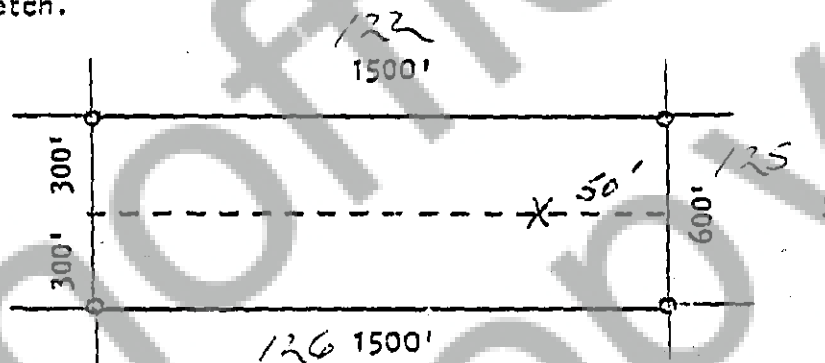
TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

West of the East End Center with the general course of the claim being East and west.
