The south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section eighteen (18), in township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian; excepting therefrom a ten (10) acre tract in the southwest corner thereof, being twenty (2) rods wide north and south, and eighty (80) rods wide East and West, the land hereby conveyed being 150 acres, in County of Skamania and State of Washington.
