

## LOCATION NOTICE

Know All Men by These Presents That Dean Robertsonthe undersigned citizen of the United States, have this 9 day ofJuly 1976, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,

approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,

1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Compass Creek lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 feet Northside and 300 feet on the South side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 1500 feetrunning West from center of discovery, and 0feet running East from center of discovery; said discovery

being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines

of said claim, in Mining District, T.4N - R6ESection 11 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

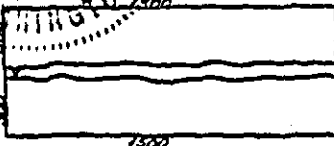
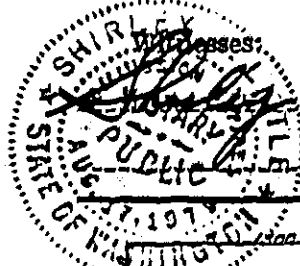
BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the NE corner), running thence 750 feet West, to a post marked X; thence 750 feet West, to a post marked 0 corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 300 feet South, to a post marked 0 corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 750 feet East, to a post marked X; thence 750 feet East, to a post marked 0 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 300 feet North, to a post marked X corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a NE direction from the center of the East end line, distant 300 feet. From Cor. No. 1 bears North distant 1500 feet and East distant 300 feet.
