July 1976, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,

1500 ft linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Westerly Sunrise # 1590 ft lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 600 feet Easterly

side and 1500 ft feet on the Southerly side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 300 ft feet

running Westerly from center of discovery 300 ft, and 300 ft

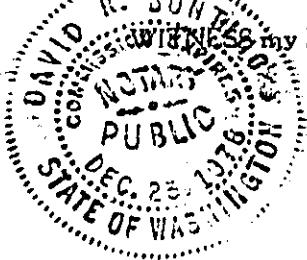
