HAZARD TO SWEENEY.

PARTIAL RELEASE.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9th day of June 1915 between Harry Hazard and Lottie Hazard, parties of the firstpart and George Sweeney and Anna E. Sweeney, his wife parties of the second part; WHEREAS said parties of the second part by Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 26th day of February, 1915, and recorded in the office of the Auditor in and for Skamania County, State of Washington, in Book M of Mortgages at page 510 n, March 3, 1915, did for the consideration and for the purpose therein mentioned mortgage the premises therein described, and Whereas the saidparty of the second part has on the day of these presents paid to the said parties of the firstpart the sum of \$120.00, lawful money of the United States, part of the money secured by the mortgage aforewaid as therein specified, being in payment of that certain note bearing date Feb. 26, 1915. due on or before two years after date,

Now therefore, this indenture witnesseth: that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the premises and the said sum of \$120. duly paid to the said parties of the first part by the said parties of the second part at the time of ensealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant, release, quitclaim and set over unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, all that part of the said mortgaged land bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 39 feet East of the Northeast corner of Lot no. one in Block Six of Riverview Addition to the Town of Stevenson, thence in an Easterly direction along second Street 86 feet, thence in a southerly direction, running on a parallel line to Lots Nos 1 and 16 of said Block 6 aforesaid, to the S.P. & S. Ry. right of way thence in a westerly direction following said right of way to a point 39 feet East of Lot no. 16 thence in a northerly direction running on a parallel line to Lots Nos. 1 and 16 to the point of beginning, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywiseappertaining; and all the lien, right, title and interest of the said parties of the first part of, in and to the same to the intent that ~~the said parties of the first part~~ that the lands hereby conveyed, and that the rest of the lands in said mortgage specified may remain to the said parties of the first part, as heretofore.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the lands and premises hereby conveyed and released to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever.
