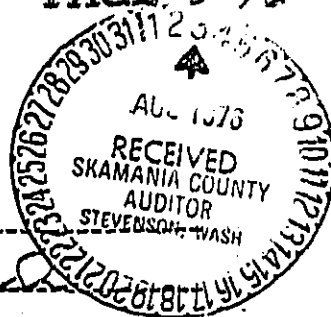


LOCATION NOTICE



Know All Men by These Presents That Alvin W. Mathis

the undersigned citizen of the United States, had this 19th day of July 1976, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, 1500 ft. linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Northwesterly Sunrise #1 lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 300 ft. feet Southwesterly side and 1500 ft. feet on the Southwesterly side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 300 ft. feet running Westwesterly from center of discovery 300 ft., and 300 ft. feet running Easterly from center of discovery 300 ft.; said discovery Sunrise #1 being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in McCoy Creek Mining District, Skamania County, Washington described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Cor. No. 1 (the Westwesterly corner), running thence 1500 feet Northwesterly, to a post marked 1500; thence 600 feet Southwesterly, to a post marked 600 corner (Cor. No. 2); thence 1500 feet Southwesterly, to a post marked 1500 corner (Cor. No. 3); thence 300 feet Southwesterly, to a post marked 300 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 300 feet Southwesterly, to a post marked 300 corner (Cor. No. 4); thence 300 feet Southwesterly, to a post marked 300 corner, the place beginning.

This claim is further described as follows: The point of discovery upon which this notice is posted is in a Northwesterly direction from the center of the Westwesterly end line, distant 300 feet. From Cor. No. 1 bears North distant 1500 ft. and 600 ft. Easterly Southwesterly 1500 bears 300 ft. to center distant 1 1/2 miles Northwesterly of Sunrise Creek a trib. of McCoy Creek T.9.N. R.3.E. Sec.22
