Know All Men by These Presents That we Max Schmidt and

 locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,

1100 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the East

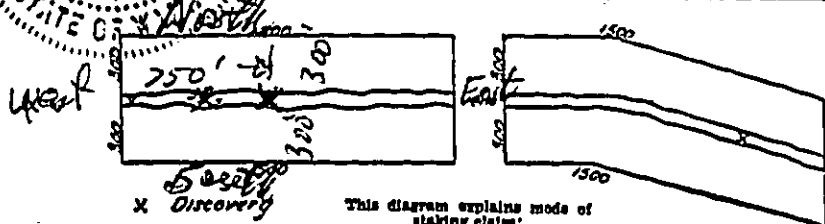
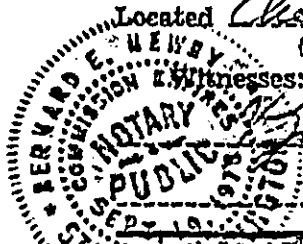
