ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Hugh W. Hamlin and George S. Whiteside (also known as Hamlin and Whiteside), of Skamania County, State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) to us in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Butler Banking Company, a corporation, that certain Indenture of Mortgage made the first day of June, A.D. 1910, by G.C. Corlie to Hugh W. Hamlin and George S. Whiteside (also known as Hamlin and Whiteside), recorded June 10, 1910, on page 291 in Book I of records of Mortgages of Skamania County, State of Washington, together with the debt and obligation thereby secured and all moneys due or to grow due thereon.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mortgage and obligation unto said Butler Banking Company and unto its successors and assigns forever.

The assignors above named do hereby covenant that they are the lawful owners and holders of said mortgage and obligation; that same is free and clear of all claims and demands of every nature and that there is unpaid upon said mortgage and obligation the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) with interest thereon from the first day of June, 1915, at the rate expressed in said mortgage and obligation.
