September 1976, located and claimed, and by these presents do

locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Act of Congress,
 approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,

1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the easterly
Sunrise #6 lode, vein, ledge or deposit along the vein thereof, with all its dips,

angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 600 feet northerly
 side and 1500 hundred feet on the easterly side of the middle
 of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins,

lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim 300 feet
 running easterly from center of discovery 300 ft., and westerly 500

feet running northerly from center of discovery 1500 feet; said discovery
Sunrise #6 being situated upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines
