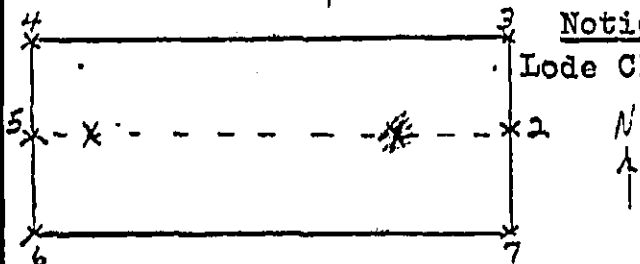

Notice of Mining Claim

Lode Claim on Public Domain

82929 TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned locator/s have discovered a vein or lode of mineral bearing rock in place upon the unappropriated public domain of the United States, within the State of Washington, and said Mining District; and in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Washington, have located a claim upon such vein or lode by posting this notice of such discovery and location on a substantial post at the point of discovery.

The name of the claim is Treemap #21. This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 100 feet East of the West End Center, further claiming all the surface rights, privileges and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is in T4N. R5E, and further described as being feet, more or less, from a natural object or permanent monument in the vicinity, to-wit: from confluence of E Fork Lewis River and Mc Kenley Creek in south half of Sec. 27 & 28

All corners are marked by blazed trees or rock cairns w/ metal tags, where applicable, and witness posts if corners cannot be reached.

Further information to-wit: All or any part of Treemap #21 is located as abandoned property.

The adjoining claims are: Treemap #14 on the west end, and #20 on the south side.
