One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen made and executed by J.W. Johnson and Mary Johnson, his wife, to the party of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars, together with the note or obligation therein described, and the money due, or to grow due thereon, with the interest; which said Indenture of Mortgage was recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County Clerk County of Skamania State of Washington in Book M of Mortgages, page 69 on the 19th day of August A.D. 1913.
